- ❖ Please remember, it is not always feasible to travel between some of our venues to umpire consecutive matches. Umpires who are asked to do this should decline. There will be points deducted for teams who provide umpires who are consistently late. Games must start on time. Unless in an emergency, umpires must not umpire more than 2 matches in a day.
- ❖ If you are unable to field a team and wish to cancel, please let me know immediately. You must also let your opponents know in good time so that they can make their arrangements. You will need to tell the teams that were due to umpire your match that they do not need to send umpires. Lastly, you will still need to fulfill your umpiring duty and will have to provide the other umpire on behalf of your opponents. Remember, if you cancel then you lose the points and generate a score of 20-0 to your opponents
- ❖ If you wish to postpone your game, please refer to League Regulations regarding the correct procedure.
- ❖ Players under 14 are not permitted to play in the league without prior permission of the League Committee.
- ❖ Please make sure that all players are members of England Netball. Checks will be made and any teams found playing an unregistered player will lose points.
- ❖ Please remember to send your score to your division rep. by **6pm on the day of the match**. If you cannot reach her, then please contact me instead. We may also be using an electronic result system this season – details to follow. We will not be phoning round for scores - remember, no score, no points. In addition, a photo of the official scorecard must be sent to Jennie Burton (jenniebennie@hotmail.co.uk) preferably straight after the match, but if not possible, then within 24 hours of the game.
- ❖ Promotion/relegation. PLEASE BE AWARE, it is likely that this season, it will continue to be 2 up and 3 down. Whilst we will always endeavor to promote 2 teams, there may be a need to relegate 3 teams if there needs to be a space made to accommodate relegation from the Regional League. In addition, we still have many divisions with 11 teams again this season. This isn't ideal, and we aim to return as many divisions as possible to 10 teams. This could therefore mean that more than 2 teams may be relegated from those divisions of 11
- ❖ Please be reminded that contact details in this fixture list are confidential and should not be shared with any outside agency, or published on any website. Clubs breaching this condition will risk suspension from the league.
- ❖ Lastly, have a good season. If you have a problem, then please don't hesitate to contact the appropriate committee member.

AVON COUNTY NETBALL ASSOCIATION – LEAGUE REGULATIONS

1. The Avon Netball League shall be governed and managed by the Avon Netball County Committee (ANA). The decisions of the ANA in respect of these rules and regulations, and on any other matter relating to the League which is not provided for below, shall be considered final and binding on all parties (subject to the right of appeal which is provided for under England Netball's disciplinary regulations). It is the responsibility of all club secretaries, coaches and captains to ensure all players and officials are conversant with the rules and regulations.
 - 1.1 Any team or official who intends to raise a query or complaint regarding the playing of a match, e.g. an incorrect player, must inform their opponents and the umpires on the day of the match. The query/complaint must be received by the League Secretary within 7 days of the match.
 - 1.2 Any query/complaint will be dealt with in the first instance by a sub-committee of the ANA, who will endeavor to provide a ruling on the issue within 10 days.
 - 1.3 In the event that an appeal is lodged against the decision of this sub-committee, an Appeals Panel will be convened. The decision of this Appeals Panel will be binding on all parties. The panel will have the authority to endorse the decision of ANA and uphold any penalty; endorse the decision of ANA and increase or decrease any penalty; overturn the decision of ANA and increase, decrease or overturn any penalty.
 - 1.4 Any complaint which does not concern the playing of a match or the result, but is made in respect of a disciplinary offence against a player or official, will be addressed in the first instance by an Investigation Committee who will act in accordance with England Netball's disciplinary regulations. This committee will present their findings to the main AN committee to decide an appropriate penalty, or, in the case of serious misconduct, may refer the complaint to England Netball.
2. Participation in the Avon Netball League is for senior teams, although junior players under 16 may participate as part of a senior team. Teams consisting wholly of juniors are not permitted. Any teams using players who are U16 (school year 11 and below) must have at least three senior players on court **at all times**. Teams who fail to maintain this ratio will be subject to the deduction of 2 points for each match affected.

Clubs who have U18 members MUST have a designated Safeguarding Lead who has completed the UK Coaching Safeguarding In Sport course and has a DBS check through England Netball. No other Safeguarding courses or DBS checks are acceptable. Coaches should also have completed the above Course and DBS check.
3. All matches will be played on dates arranged by the League Secretary.
 - 3.1 Each match will consist of a full length game of four quarters of 15 minutes and be governed by current EN rules. Copies of these rules can be found on the EN website.
 - 3.2 Points will be awarded as follows : - 5 pts for a win, 3 for a draw, 2 pts if within 5 goals and 1 pt if the losing team scores over 50% of the winning team's score. Winning teams must notify their Divisional Rep of the score by 6pm on the day of the match. In the event of a draw, both teams should pass on the result. If unable to contact the Div.Rep., the League Secretary should be contacted direct.
 - 3.3 Teams that submit scores late will be deducted one point for each occasion this occurs.
 - 3.4 At the end of the season, numbers of teams involved in promotion and relegation will be decided by the League Committee. Teams that tie on points shall have their positions determined as follows:
 - Goal average shall be used to determine positions - the team with the higher average score over the course of the season shall take precedence.
 - In the event that goal average does not differentiate between the teams, then goal difference shall be applied- precedence shall be given to the team with the greater difference between goals scored and goals conceded
 - In the event that goal difference does not differentiate between the teams, then the team with the greatest number of goals scored shall take precedence
 - In the event that applying the above cannot differentiate between the teams, the aggregate score in the match or matches played between them over the course of the season shall be calculated and precedence given to the winning team.
4. Players may only represent one club at any one time within the league during the season. If a player wishes to leave an existing club and join another part way through the season, she must apply to the League Secretary,

stating her reasons for leaving. The League Committee reserve the right to approach both clubs prior to making a decision. Players wishing to change club must not play for their new club until a) notification has been received from the League Secretary and b) a minimum 2-week period (from the time of the request) has elapsed. Teams playing players who have not informed the League Secretary will be liable to loss of points (2 points per player per game) and loss of deposit. A player may not transfer to another club after Feb 27th 2027, unless in exceptional circumstances.

- 5 Each **CLUB** must send a representative to the AGM. Failure to do so will result in a fine, which will be loss of deposit.
6. A League Affiliation fee must be paid per team by the date stipulated by the League Committee. The fee will be ratified at the AGM.
- 7 Each club must affiliate to the County and each player to EN as stipulated in the Constitution. Failure to do so will render the club ineligible to play in the League. Teams playing unregistered players will be liable to the loss of 5 points for each occasion any such player has played, and loss of deposit.
 - 7.1 Players playing in the Avon League must be first registered (a primary member) to the club they are representing unless covered by Rule 3. If a club wishes to second affiliate a player who is a primary member of another club from a different league, permission must be sought from the League Secretary. No more than two 2nd claim players per season may be registered. Primary members of regional teams may not second affiliate to play in the Avon League. In addition, players who already play for an Avon club may not 2nd affiliate to another Avon club to play within the Avon League, unless covered under rule 3.
 - 7.2 No player under 14 may play in the league without permission from the League Committee. When seeking permission, evidence that the player concerned is physically and emotionally ready to play senior netball will be required – e.g. from an ADC coach/ satellite academy coach
8. Matches will be played at netball centres decided upon by the County Committee. Postponements are only allowed at the discretion of the League Committee. Any such requests must be made in writing to the League Secretary at least one month in advance of the game, unless for unforeseen circumstances.
 - 8.1 If two or more players are participating in an EN organised event of which the League Committee is aware, a request for postponement will be automatically granted. Postponements for any other reason will be dealt with at the discretion of the League Committee.
 - 8.2 A team allowed to postpone will still have to fulfil its umpiring commitments for the Saturday concerned by providing the **TWO UMPIRES** required.
 - 8.3 Except in the case of bad weather, postponed games must be played within 6 weeks of the original date. The team not responsible for the postponement must offer a minimum of 4 dates, of which at least one should be at the weekend. Once the date has been agreed and confirmed, the match must be played or forfeited by the team unable to play.
 - 8.4 If a game is abandoned, a report should be made to the League Secretary by both teams and the umpires. Captains and umpires need to discuss very carefully why they consider the game needs to be abandoned before doing so. The League Committee, taking due regard of the score, will decide the outcome of the game, but in general results will stand if a game is abandoned due to injury or bad weather during the 3rd or 4th quarter.
 - 8.5 If a team concedes during a game, the umpires should sign both score cards, stating the name of the team conceding.
 - 8.6 Postponements due to weather conditions will only be authorized by the League Secretary, or in his/her absence, by a representative from the county committee. In times of bad weather, when matches are in doubt, division reps will contact clubs concerned and notifications will be posted on the Avon Netball and Avon Umpires Facebook pages.
 - 8.7 If reserve dates are used for re-arranged games, teams unable to fulfil their fixtures on these dates must apply for a postponement within the specified timescale given. No postponements will be granted outside of this period unless covered by rule 7.1
 - 8.8 If a team is unable to play and concedes their game, a score of 20-0 will be awarded to the non-defaulting team. The team conceding must provide both umpires and scorers for the corresponding umpiring commitment.
9. Each club must have registered to them the appropriate umpire(s), qualification as stated on the current fixture list, to officiate at their designated matches. There must be the correct number of umpires for the number of teams entered.
 - 9.1 In the event of only one umpire being present at a match, the game will be postponed. The teams concerned shall arrange a mutually convenient date and venue for the match to be replayed. The team who failed to supply the umpire shall be subject to the conditions outlined in Rule 10.
 - 9.2 It is a League requirement that clubs use their own umpires for **over** 50% of their **total matches**.

Matches that are postponed will not be included in the total % needed. Teams who do not fulfil this requirement will be subject to loss of points as follows: 15 points deducted if less than 25%, 10 points if between 26 – 50 %. Clubs who do not have the required number and qualification of umpires will be subject to withheld points, which will be released once qualification has been attained, as follows:

C award - 25% of points will be released once the required number have attended an Into Umpiring course. A further 25% will be released once an Into assessment has been passed. This will be followed by a further 25% once the required number have attended a C course. Full points will be awarded on the candidates have completed a C assessment, irrespective of whether they meet the criteria for assessment. All requests for assessment must be received by 14th March 2027.

B award – clubs will be allowed two consecutive seasons for the required number of umpires to attain the B award. During the first of those seasons, the prospective umpire (s) must have completed a B award course.. During the second season (or before if appropriate), the prospective umpire must have an assigned mentor who has been appointed by the Avon Netball umpiring committee. Trainee B award umpires who have been cleared to umpire in Div 1 must have an annual reaccreditation to ensure the appropriate standard is being met.

9.3 There is no extra time allowed for umpires to travel between venues. Games must start at the time specified on the fixture list. Umpires who persistently arrive later than 5 minutes after the start time of their game may incur a fine for the club they were umpiring for.

9.4 Each team shall provide a scorer to accompany their umpire. Teams that fail to provide scorers may face loss of deposit. Persistent offenders will also be subject to the loss of 1 point on each occasion.

10 In the event of a team failing to fulfil their umpiring commitment, they will be deducted 2 points, lose their deposit and incur all the expenses of the rearranged match. The deposit must be repaid by the date stipulated by the League Secretary to enable the team to continue playing in the league.

10.1 Second and subsequent offences of failing to provide an umpire will result in the loss of deposit and loss of 5 points each time. Persistent offenders may face suspension from the league.

10.2 A team who is unable to fulfil their umpiring commitment must inform the teams they are due to umpire by **2 pm of the Thursday before the match**. The defaulting team will be: a) responsible for the expenses of the rearranged game b) responsible for paying the umpires sent by the postponed teams who still have to fulfil their duty umpiring the defaulting team's match.

11. An initial deposit of £20 must be lodged with the Treasurer when first entering the League. This is refundable in the event of a team retiring from the League at the end of the season, providing all their commitments have been fulfilled. If a team withdraws before the end of the season, the deposit is forfeited.

11.1 The deposit is also used as a fine for breach of rules. When repaying a deposit due to a fine, it increases to £30.

11.2 New teams will join the League in the lowest division, unless the League Committee uses its discretion to place them in a higher position.

12. Teams will take to the court at the allotted time once both umpires are present. Play will start provided both teams have 5 or more players. Teams **must** take to the court with 5 players. If one team has not arrived or has fewer than 5 players present, once the match start time is reached, the umpires will start timing and for **each full minute** that the defaulting team does not take to the court, they will award one goal to the non-offending team. Once the late team has arrived, play can start but the first quarter will end 15 mins from when the umpires first started their watches. There will be no extension of time, or starting of the game from the beginning because of the late arrivals. When the late team arrives, timing and awarding of goals continues whilst they prepare themselves to take the court. If after 15 mins the absent team has not arrived then the game will be awarded to the team that is present, unless a genuine reason is offered by the defaulting team. If the game is awarded, the goal fine will not count.

13. At the start of the season, each club must fill in a squad sheet, which should be returned to the League Secretary. Specific rules are in place regarding the eligibility of named squad members. Please see the Player Category Sheet guidelines for specific details.

14. Pregnancy. Avon Netball have adopted the EN rules regarding pregnancy in umpires and players. Please see current EN guidance.

15. Discipline. Clubs are reminded that they are responsible for their players and spectators. Rough or dangerous play, verbal or physical intimidation, misconduct or other inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated, and will be dealt with according to EN's discipline code.

16. Any item not covered by these regulations will be dealt with at the League Committee's discretion.

17. From July 2026 all previous Rules and Regulations are hereby revoked.
